Job Description

ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

AFAAH is a Christ-centered, discipleship ministry that assists women seeking recovery from addiction, past abuse, and/or homelessness for various reasons. The live-in RA **must** be a faithful follower of Jesus Christ who **attends church regularly** (pastor reference required) and who exhibits the following qualities:

- Personal, biblical Integrity in all areas of life; Is trustworthy. Trust is essential for this role.
(Background check required)
- Strong interpersonal/relational abilities; exhibits the fruit of the spirit (Galatians 5) when interacting with people
- Ongoing commitment to personal growth; able to receive constructive criticism if necessary

DUTIES

1. **Be on campus at 7:00 pm every day** (7 days/week); Negotiable times/days for the right candidate
2. To secure both buildings each evening, turning off unnecessary lights, making sure the women have cleaned up after dinner and that the oven/stove is off, coffee pots are off, and alarms are set in both buildings. Make sure women are keeping the AFAAH living area clean and that all bedrooms (including RA room) are free of clutter
3. The RA is not a counseling or disciplinary role; it is a supportive role to the director. The RA reports problems with the building itself (AC not working, water issues, etc.), any behavioral problems, or if a client decides to leave the facility in the middle of the night (no re-entry if they leave) to the director.

QUALIFICATIONS

Non-smoker (AFAAH is a smoke-free ministry as we lead women out of addiction), HS diploma/GED, Faithful Church Attendance, Able to climb stairs without difficulty (AFAAH is located on the 2nd floor of the church), loving and positive attitude, able to adhere to the confidentiality standards of AFAAH.
